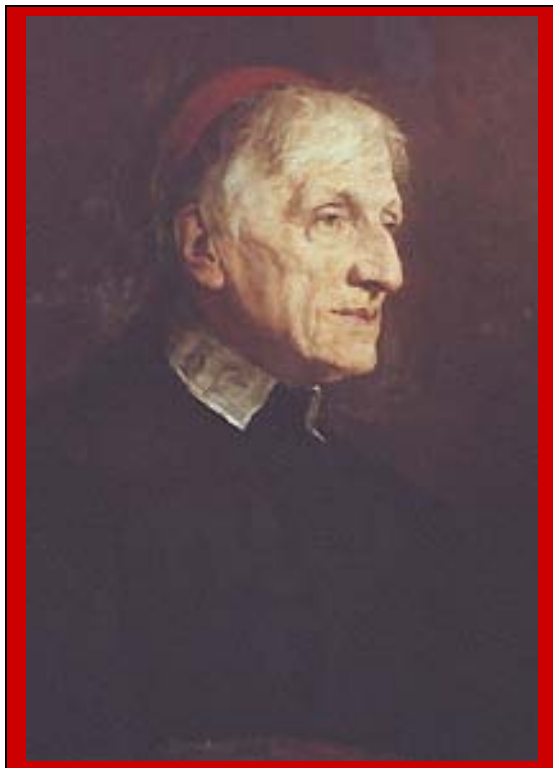

Blessed John Henry Newman

for the patron of our society. Pope Benedict XVI beatified Cardinal Newman in the city of his Oratory, Birmingham, England, on September 19, 2010. This 1879 painting by W. W. Oules was used in the ceremony.

Conference Theme: Newman and Education

Proposals are invited on all aspects of the topic, such as Newman's own writings on education, their sources, their relationship to contemporary issues of whatever nature, his career in Oxford or Dublin, his views relating Christian faith to science or literature, etc.

Email proposals of 100-150 words to Prof. Ed Miller (miller.e@gmc.edu) by Newman's birthday, 21 February. Include your full name, title, institution, address, and phone number. Selection of presenters will be made in a very timely fashion. Convention planners envision a schedule of no more than two presentations at any one time. Special plenary sessions engaging all convention participants are foreseen.

"According to the request of our Brother, Bernard Longley, Archbishop of Birmingham, of many other Brothers in the episcopate, and many of the faithful, after consultation with the Congregation for the Causes of Saints, by our apostolic authority we declare that the venerable Servant of God, John Henry Cardinal Newman, priest of the Congregation of the Oratory, shall henceforth be invoked as Blessed and that his feast shall be celebrated every year on the ninth of October, in the places and according to the norms established by Church law. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."
